Volunteer Department	Job Description
Hospitality (tickets, special events, Delray Beach Open Food & Wine	This team will provide support and assistance to patrons all over the site.
Series)	Role and responsibilities will include, but are not limited to: Front of the
	House - Tickets (greeting fans - scanning tickets at the gate) and
	hospitality (greet/check-in patrons as the Hospitality Pavilion, parties,
	etc.), providing direction to fans on-site, assist in Event Info Booth,
	providing guest services at special events, checking patrons into VIP
	Clubhouse, provide problem solving skills and excellent customer service.
Ushers	Stationed on-site (Event Entrance, in-Stadium, Side Court 1) primarily to
	monitor patron behavior, provide guidance, and assist with any problems
	that arise.
	Responsibilities include but not limited to: helping patrons find their
	seating, monitoring movement within matches, monitoring credential only
	access points, problem solving, directing patrons to areas on site,
	assisting on court patrons to their seats, maintain a safe environment, and
	provide excellent customer service. Must be able to handle large crowds.
Transportation	Responsible for transporting players to and from any desired destination,
	whether that be the airport, hotel, back to the site, or other approved
	locations. They should be safe drivers and will be required to provide
	license and insurance documentation prior to approval.
Credentials	Assist with the distribution of Credentials to all players (and guests),
	officials, employees, and all other individuals who require credential
	access. Must be able to use laptops, computers, camera, and printers to process credentials.
Office/Will Call	The roles and requests will be, but are not limited to, answering phones,
	directing phone calls, answering questions to the best of their ability,
	taking messages, distributing will call tickets, utilizing problem solving
	skills, and providing excellent customer service.
Player Services	Act as the Concierge Services for the players and their guests.
	Examples include: Schedule and assist with player practice times, assign
	hitters for players, providing players with drinks, snacks and meal
	vouchers, monitoring laundry services, initiating player guest tickets to
	matches, answering phone calls, problem solving, informing players and
	guests about on-site services and local attractions, and providing
	excellent customer service.
	ABOVE ALL, player services volunteers will provide an exceptional and
	professional experience for ALL players, guests, and officials they assist.
Volunteer Services	This team will assist our group of 300+ volunteers throughout the
	tournament. The role will include, but is not limited to, maintaining an
	orderly volunteer establishment, communicating with food services to
	receive and distribute meals, refilling and distributing refreshments,
	distributing meal vouchers, problem solving skills, and assisting the group
	as needed.
